**Main Responsibilities :**

To promote the work of the SMU work, support local delivery and act as a focal point for the network of Certificate in the Management of Drug Misuse holders in the East Midlands Region as outlined below :

1. Attendance at the Clinical Leads Away Day in January each year
2. To support the delivery of the Certificate programme through mentorship, facilitation and contribution to development of course materials
3. Establish and maintain links with DAT, PCTs, SHAs NTA and Shared Care Monitoring Groups in the region and provide consultancy and sign posting to relevant support services
4. To provide a Regional Development Plan which details the key objectives and outputs that the lead will seek to provide across the region with respect to facilitating and improving the quality of services to drug misusers in primary care setting across the region.
