# What is CJIP?

- An initiative with an overall goal of reducing drug related offending

## By

- Developing and providing integrated care pathways into and through treatment

## For

- Those people identified as drug using offenders within the criminal justice system

# Aims and Objectives

- Reduce drug related crime by directing drug using offenders out of crime and into treatment
- Identify drug using offenders within the criminal justice system - increase the numbers contacted and offered help
- Provide quick access to assessment, comprehensive care planning and referral to a full range of relevant and appropriate services - increase the numbers entering and engaging with treatment
- Through a case management approach provide co-ordination supervision and support throughout the client's progress through care - increase numbers completing their care programme

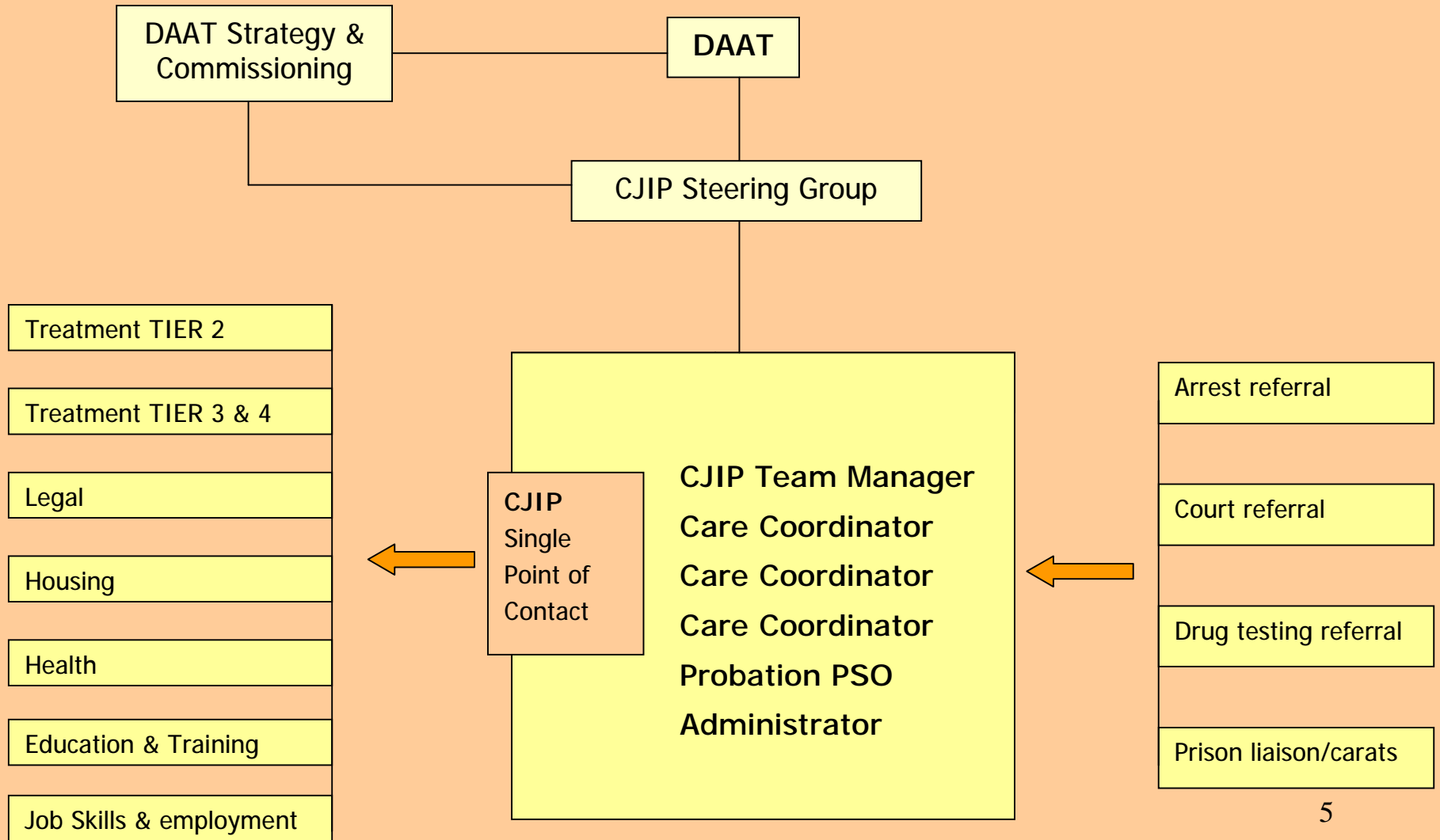

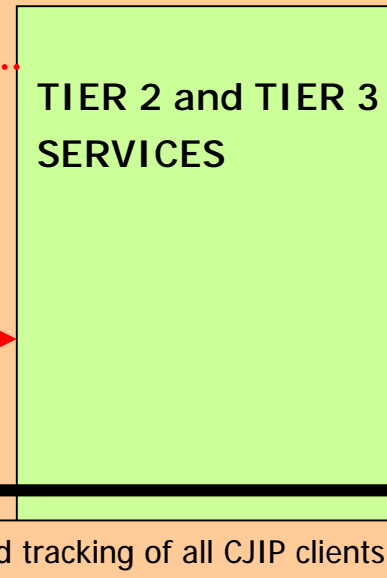
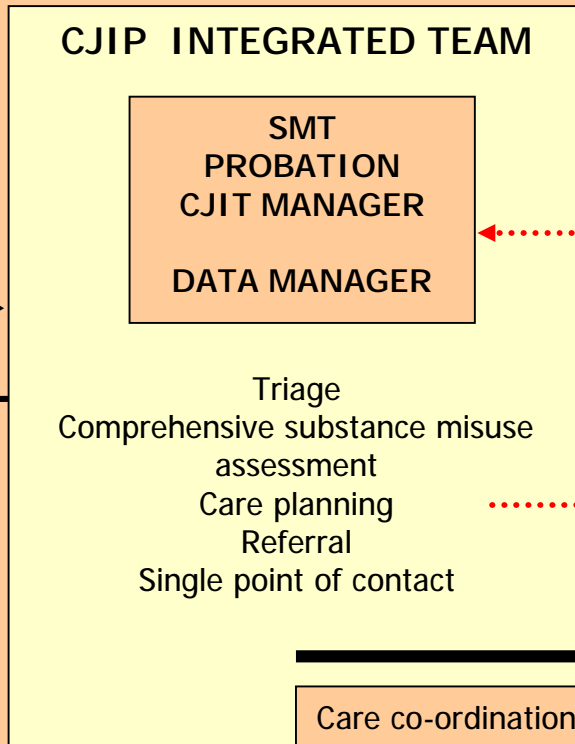
